ACHS At-A-Glance

Archbishop Carroll High School (ACHS) is a co-educational International Baccalaureate school under the direction of the Archdiocese of Washington. ACHS welcomes a diverse student body from over 40 nationalities, 35 zip codes and 60 feeder schools.

9th-12th GRADE: A co-educational, International Baccalaureate school under the Archdiocese of Washington serving 400 students from DC, MD and VA.

SMALL NURTURING CLASSES: 11:1 student-teacher ratio

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: ACHS curriculum revolves around the International Baccalaureate Programme. Through a partnership with Catholic University of America, students can take courses for free and receive university credit.

COLLEGE PREPARATORY: In the last 5 years, Archbishop Carroll High School students have been accepted to 145 colleges including Columbia University, Dartmouth, Georgetown, University of Virginia and Xavier University.

TUITION ASSISTANCE: Students with exceptional academic potential are named Augustine Scholars. Archdiocesan employees receive a 50% tuition rate.

TRANSPORTATION: Archbishop Carroll High School is conveniently located on the Red Line near Brookland/CUA Metro. A shuttle is available to the school along with ample student parking.

STEM PROGRAM: Archbishop Carroll has a new Engineering Program aimed at engaging students through specialized courses in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) designed by Project Lead the Way (PLTW). Carroll's engineering program offers students hands-on activities that enable them to solve complex, open-ended problems in a real world context.

SERVICE TO STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS: Carroll welcomes students with diverse learning differences. They provide resources to enable their students to achieve success such as extended time on tests, organizational support and assistance with self-advocacy.

Tuition and Fees

TUITION ONLY: *The college preparatory education Archbishop Carroll provides—anchored in the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme and animated by Catholic values—costs close to \$18,000 per student to provide. Thanks to generous donors, tuition for the 2016-2017 school year is \$13,146, so every Archbishop Carroll student receives almost \$5,000 in scholarship and tuition assistance.*

- Additional One-Time Fees (First Year Only): Application Fee \$25, Registration Fee \$300, I-20 Processing Fee \$250, Orientation \$1000

TUITION AND RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM: *Ellacy partners with a third-party residential provider to host international students while they attend school at Archbishop Carroll High School. This residential program is not a part of ACHS's housing services.*

- International Students pays \$34,000 including tuition and residential while **Ellacy Students pays \$22,746 per academic year including tuition and residential, equivalent to 33.1% scholarship.**
- Additional One-Time Fees (First Year Only): Application Fee \$25, Registration Fee \$300, I-20 Processing Fee \$250, Orientation \$1000

Costs do not include textbooks, uniform, sport selective expenses, transportation, health insurance and other personal expenses.

Merit Scholarships

Merit scholarships are available for incoming 9th graders. The admissions committee will review grades, test scores, teacher recommendations and essays for qualified applicants. Recipients will be notified at the time of acceptance.

International students who meet particularly distinguished academic criteria upon application are eligible for consideration as Augustine Scholars. International Augustine Scholars may receive between **\$1,500** and **\$3,000** in merit scholarship assistance, renewable for multiple years if students maintain a grade point average of 3.0, participate in mandatory Augustine Scholar activities, and remain strong participants in our school community.

The school also offers a limited number of music scholarships for student-musicians who play brass or woodwind instruments. Music scholarships typically range from **\$500-\$1,000** per year and are renewable as long as students continue to participate in the school's instrumental music program.
